Healthy Eating Policy



We now operate a healthy eating policy, the children are offered a choice of milk or water. We would however, like parents to provide a piece of fruit for each session, please try to be creative. The odd packet of breadsticks or pitta bread would be useful too. This food is offered to children at snack time.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR YOUR ATTENTION

- (1) All parents are advised to bring their children in suitable clothing remembering that there are paints, pastes and other substances that could spoil good clothing. Aprons are provided for the children and paints used are washable, but accidents do happen. When children go to the toilet we encourage them to be self-reliant, so clothing that is easy for them to pull up/down or remove should be worn. Appropriate footwear must also be worn. Please, no backless shoes, mules, or wellies.
- (2) If your child has been sick, or has had diarrhoea please keep them at home for **48 hours** to ensure the condition is clear before returning to the nursery.
- (3) **TOILET TRAINING:** Please discuss with your child's key person how they are progressing, so that we may all work together in understanding each child's needs.
