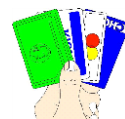

**AFTERNOON SESSIONS...**We are open on Monday, Thursday and Friday at 12.40 - 3pm. The cost will be £10 per session. Please let us know if you would either like to swap or require extra sessions. For children who attend morning sessions it is possible for them to stay from 12.10 until 3pm on these days with a packed lunch supplied by you. This will cost £11 per session. Fees are payable on the day.



**Photo Name Cards are out each session on your child's table to enable children to learn to read and find their name on a daily basis. Please encourage your child to return their name card to their key worker at the end of the session.**

### IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE....

Please ensure that your child should not wear any jewelry or belts and should have sensible shoes while at nursery. One piece of fruit per child is needed each session. We will provide a choice of milk, or water and encourage independence by allowing children to pour their own drinks. Perhaps they could do this at home as well under your supervision? Our letter and number of the week is displayed in the book corner, Please encourage your child to look for that letter anywhere, shopping, road signs, reading books at home and suchlike. our aim is to develop our children's skills in a fun and positive way, learning through play, your support outside the nursery is very important. We supply aprons for children and kitchen roll for hand drying. We would like parents to donate one kitchen roll and one pack of baby wipes per half term. Nursery Times are **9.15 till 12.10** in the morning and **12.40 till 3.00pm** in the afternoon. Please try to be punctual when dropping off and collecting children, so that staff can get on with their activities and be able to clear away at the end of the session.

### OUTSIDE PLAY

**It is an OFSTED requirement that children should take part in outside play activities every day, so please make sure your child is provided with suitable clothing for this activity.**
