NAME CARDS are out each session on your child's table to enable children to learn to read and find their name on a daily basis. Please encourage your child to hand this back to their key worker each session when you collect them, so they can be marked off the register.

One piece of fruit, or bread sticks, or pitta bread per child is needed each session. We will provide a choice of milk, or water and encourage independence by allowing children to pour their own drinks. Perhaps they could do this at home as well under your supervision.

We would like parents to donate one kitchen roll and one pack of baby wipes each per half term. If your child is in nappies, please put at least 2 spare nappies in their nursery bag.

Please be aware that dropping off and collecting children has its problems with the amount of cars, please be courteous and park considerately, or better still, if you can, leave the car at home.

Please be mindful that children and parents like to breathe clean air, so to ensure a healthy environment for all please do not leave car engines running in the parking areas.
