
Healthy Eating Policy



We operate a healthy eating policy at Trinity Hall , the children should bring in a named water bottle every day (no juice or milk) We would however, like parents to provide a daily snack such as a piece of cut up fruit, vegetables in a named container (carrots/cucumber) bread sticks/pitta for each session please. This food will be given to children at mid morning snack time.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR YOUR ATTENTION

- Warm clothes this term a jumper and coat,hat,scarf and no wellies (bring trainers in so they can change)
- We use aprons for painting an messy play but sometimes the children may get their clothes dirty so please wear old clothes. (Or see Maureen for a Trinity Hall Sweater)
