IMPORTANT NOTES FOR YOUR ATTENTION

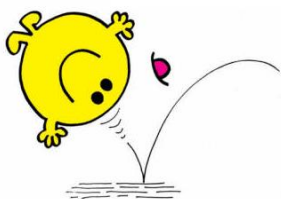
(1) All parents are advised to bring their children in suitable clothing remembering that there are paints, pastes and other substances that could spoil good clothing. Aprons are provided for the children and paints used are washable, but accidents do happen. When children go to the toilet we encourage them to be independent, so clothing that is easy for them to pull up/down or remove should be worn. Appropriate footwear must also be worn. Please, no backless shoes, mules, wellies. or crocs.

(2) If your child has been sick, or has had diarrhoea please keep them at home for 48 hours

(3) TOILET TRAINING: Please discuss with your child's key person with your child's progress, so that we may all work together in understanding each individual child's needs.

(4) Please do not let your children bring personal toys into the nursery, they can be easily lost.

In the unfortunate case that your child has an accident or incident at home, we require you to complete a form with a body map to show the position of the injury. The reason for this is it may affect the child's behaviour or cause concern to staff if we are not made aware.
